The original Providence Mandolin Orchestra was founded in 1911 by William Place Jr. Today's PMO dates from the early 1970s, when it was revived by Hibbard Perry. Since then, the PMO has become the leading American mandolin ensemble with regular performances throughout the eastern United States and multiple tours to Europe. The PMO is dedicated to the performance of original contemporary music, including many pieces written for the ensemble. Mark Davis has served as the PMO's music director since 1989.
